Community Development Block Grant (CDBG)

Proposed Annual Action Plan FY 2025 -2026

The City of Southfield will propose funds for the following activities for FY 2025/2026 with the Community Development Block Grant Funds, reprogrammed funds, and program income from the Southfield Home Improvement Program (SHIP).

2025/2026 Entitlement Funds totaling \$TBD

1. Administration: Administrative costs for running the CDBG program. Expenditures include wages, supplies, legal notices, etc. **\$75,000**
2. Fair Housing: Promotes equal and fair housing through the Fair Housing Center of Metropolitan Detroit. **\$2,000**
3. HAVEN: Provides services related to the needs of those affected by domestic violence. **\$5,000**
4. Lighthouse of Michigan: Provides services to people experiencing homelessness. **\$1,500**
5. Southfield Youth Assistance (SYA): Provides funds for scholarships for low/moderate income youth for skill building education and recreational programs, camps, etc. **\$20,000**
6. Emergency Relief Fund (ERF): Provides interim care to low/moderate income residents to prevent evictions, utility shut offs, and provides food and medication. **\$35,000**
7. Southfield Home Improvement Program (SHIP): Provides loans to low/moderate income homeowners to repair their homes. **\$65,000 plus revolving loan funds.**
8. Chore Program: Helps low/moderate income seniors with funds for minor home repair. **\$150,000**
9. Rebuilding Together: Assists low/moderate income families with home improvements using the help of volunteers. **\$15,000**
