Purpose The Constitution of the United States guarantees fundamental rights and freedoms to all citizens, which cannot be infringed upon by any state. Louisiana has consistently violated federal rights, including the rights to a fair trial, equal protection under the law, and the right to vote, among other civil liberties. The state's legal and governmental systems have engaged in practices

that disproportionately harm marginalized communities, foster systemic discrimination, and undermine the rule of law. The persistence of these violations requires immediate federal
